

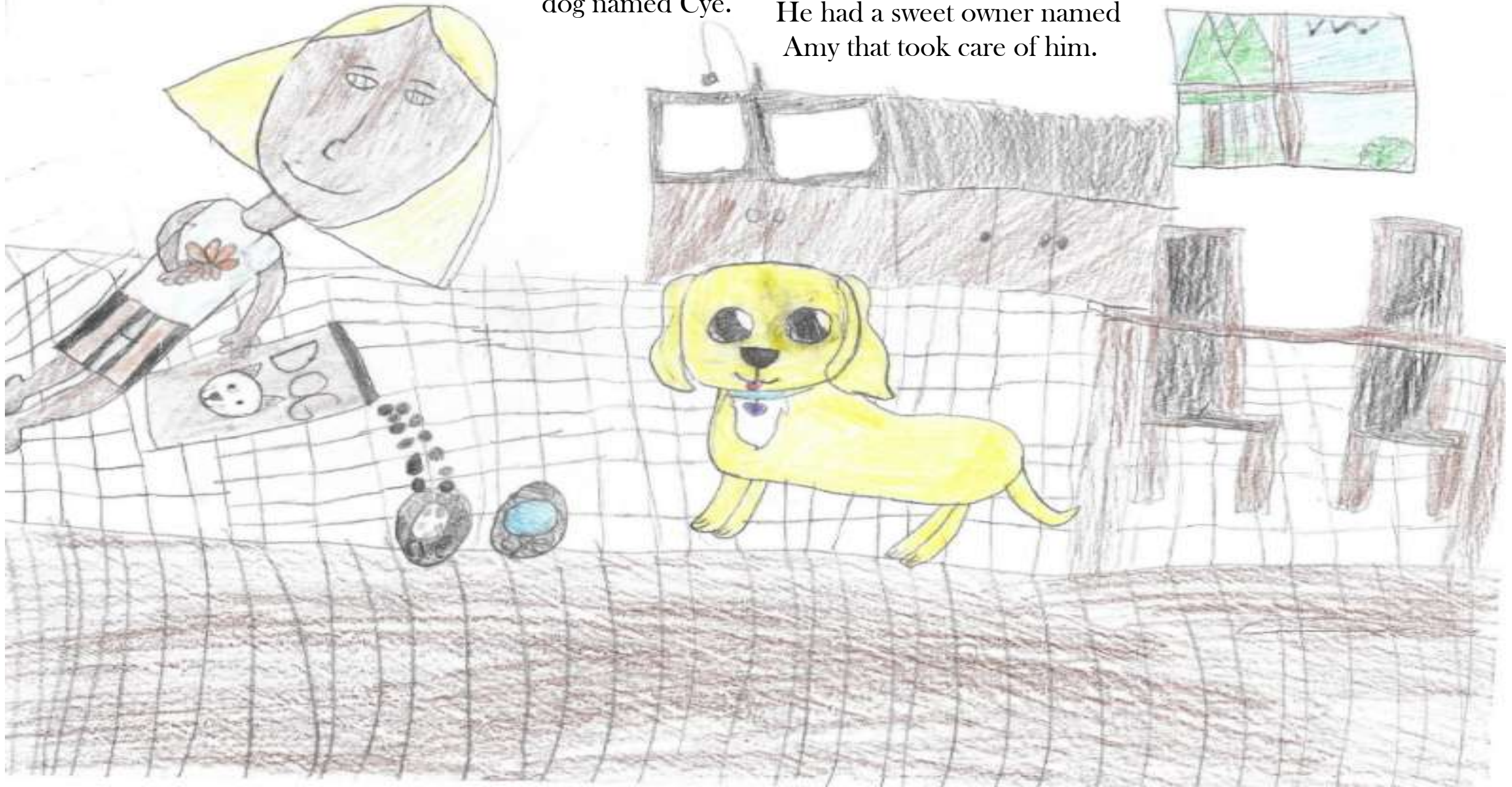
# Miracle Dog

Amy that took care of him.

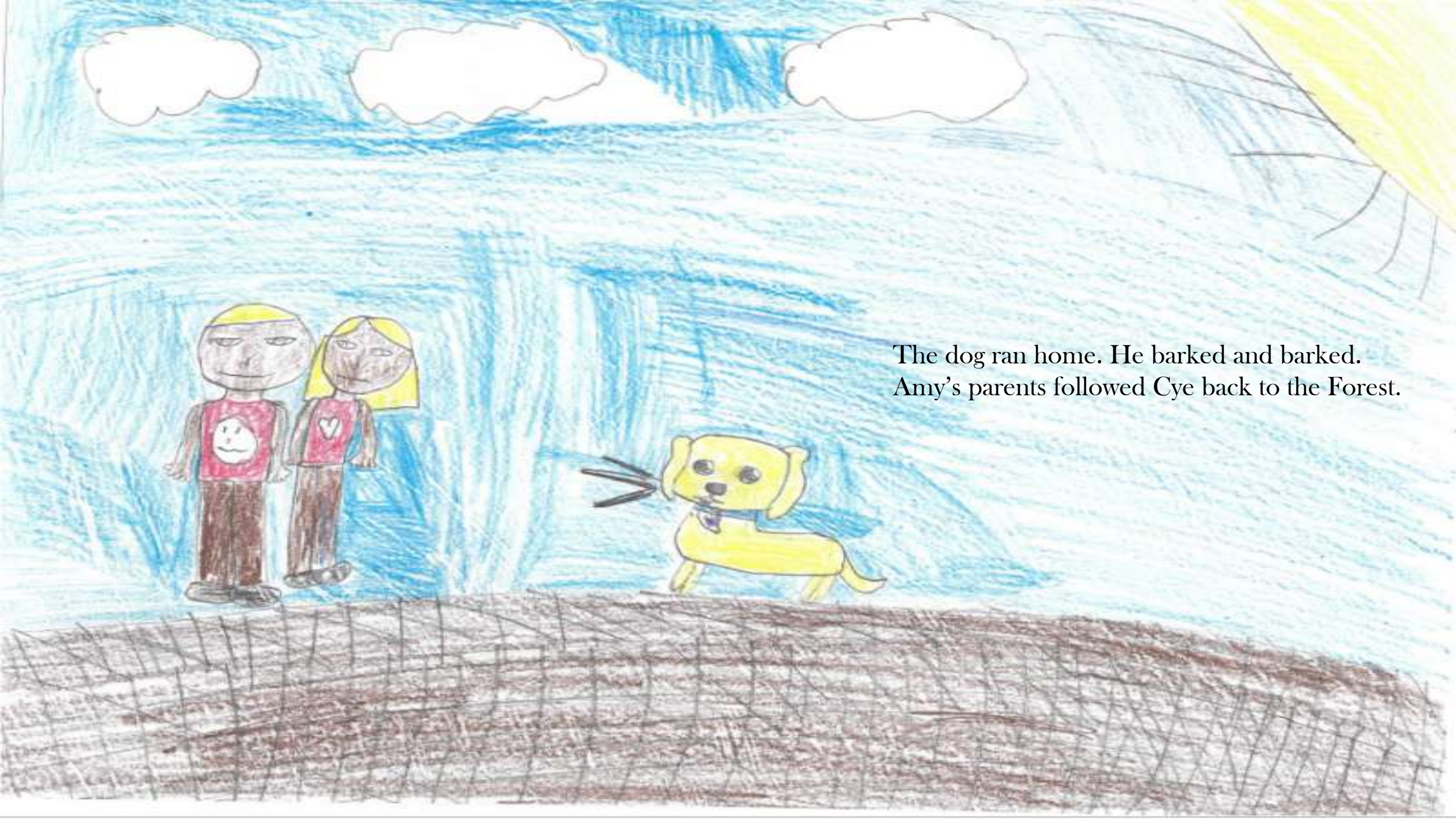






They played in the forest every day.

Amy got lost in the woods.



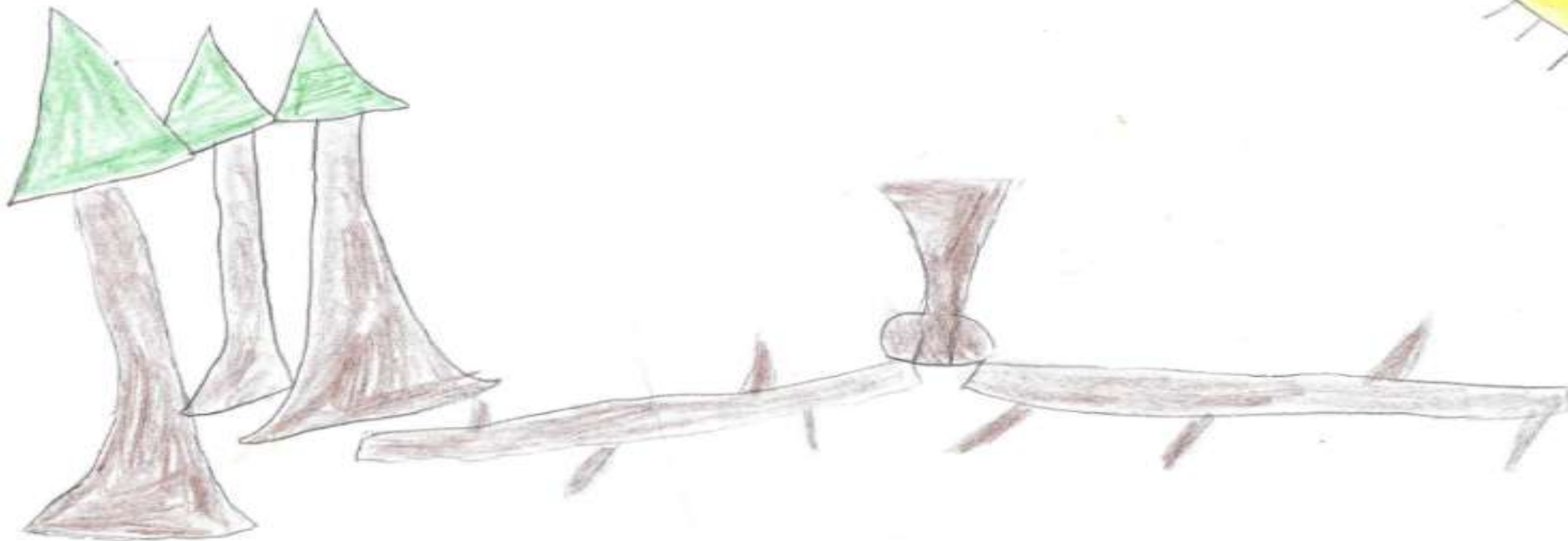


The dog ran home. He barked and barked.  
Amy's parents followed Cye back to the Forest.



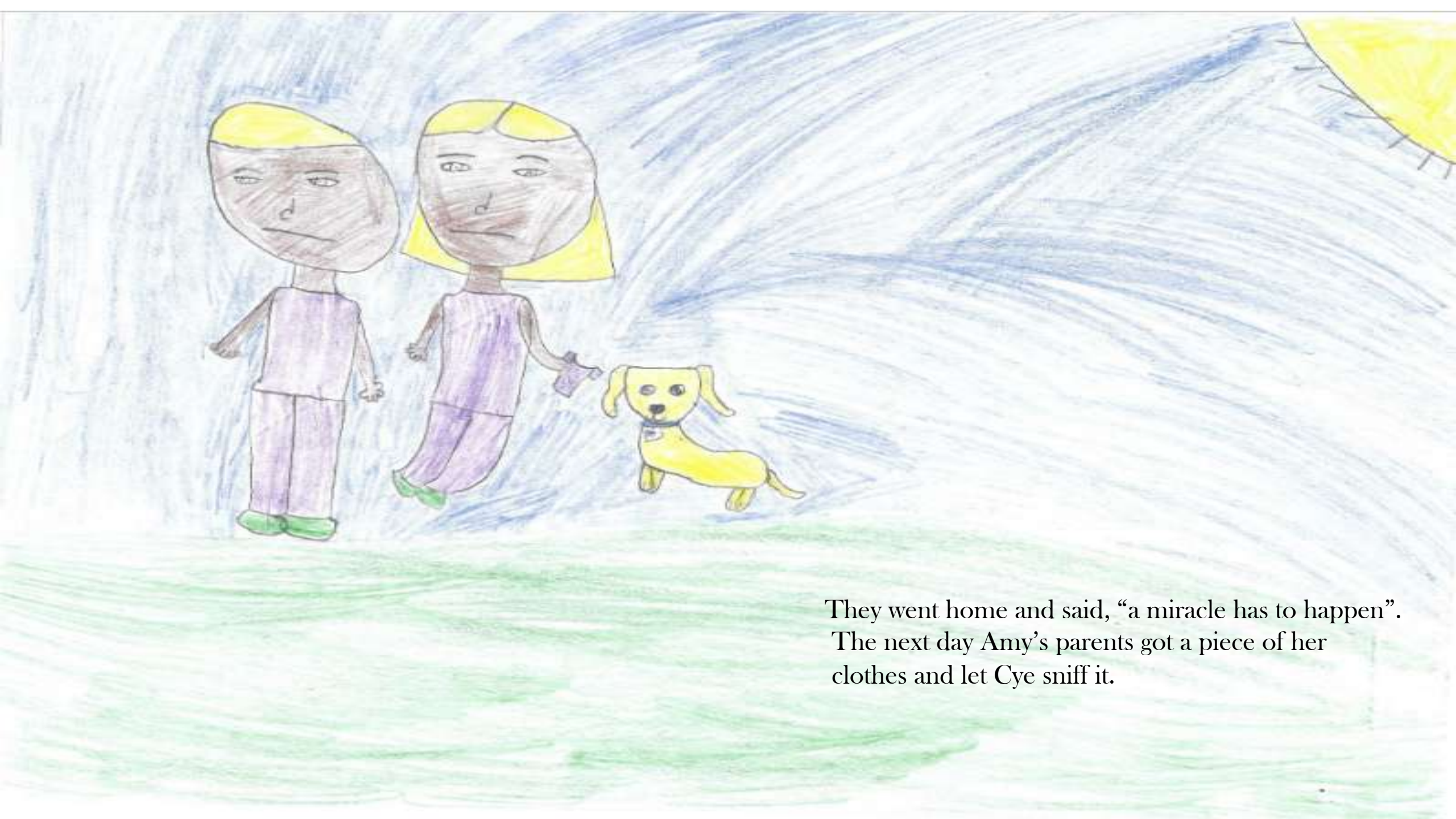


Her family looked and looked day and night.

They made a shelter and slept until the next day.

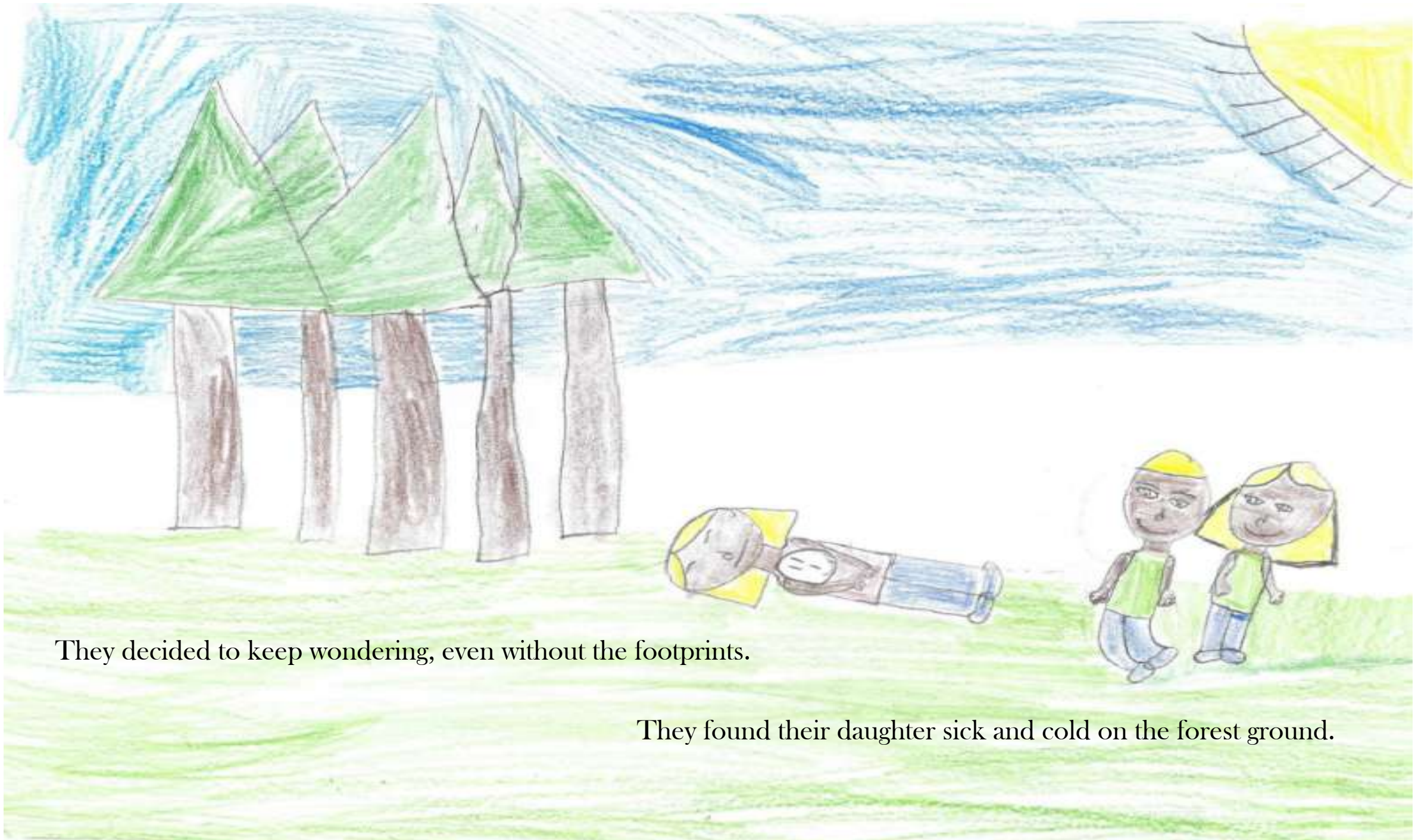






It was the next day.

They were washed away by the rain.



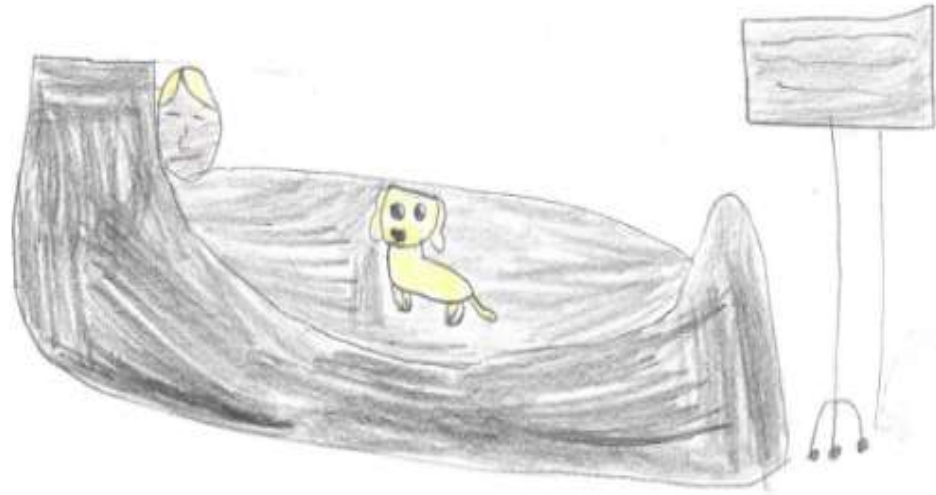


They decided to keep wondering, even without the footprints.
